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This Amendment No. 1 to the Issuer Tender Offer Statement on Schedule TO relates to the results of an offer by Sirius Satellite Radio Inc., a Delaware corporation (the "Company"), to exchange all of the Company's outstanding $83 / 4 \%$ Convertible Subordinated Notes due 2009 (the "Convertible Notes") for the Company's common stock, par value $\$ 0.001$ per share ("Common Stock"), upon the terms and subject to the conditions contained in the Prospectus and Solicitation Statement dated January 30,2003 and the related Letter of Transmittal and Consent.

The Company reports that $\$ 14,717,000$ in principal amount, or $89.41 \%$ of the outstanding principal amount, of the Convertible Notes was tendered in the exchange offer for the Company's Common Stock. Pursuant to the terms of the exchange offer, holders of a majority in aggregate principal amount of, and accrued interest on, the outstanding debt of the Company reduced the minimum tender condition to the exchange offer to $90 \%$ in aggregate principal amount of outstanding indebtedness and eliminated any minimum requirement with respect to the Convertible Notes. On March 7, 2003, the Company issued an aggregate of $12,436,656$ shares of Common Stock to holders of 8 3/4\% Convertible Subordinated Notes due 2009 who had validly tendered in the exchange offer.

This Amendment No. 1 to the Issuer Tender Offer Statement on Schedule TO
is being filed in satisfaction of the reporting requirements of Rule 13e-4 (c) (4) promulgated under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended.
